When I play with my friends at the pool, I won't splash or push them.



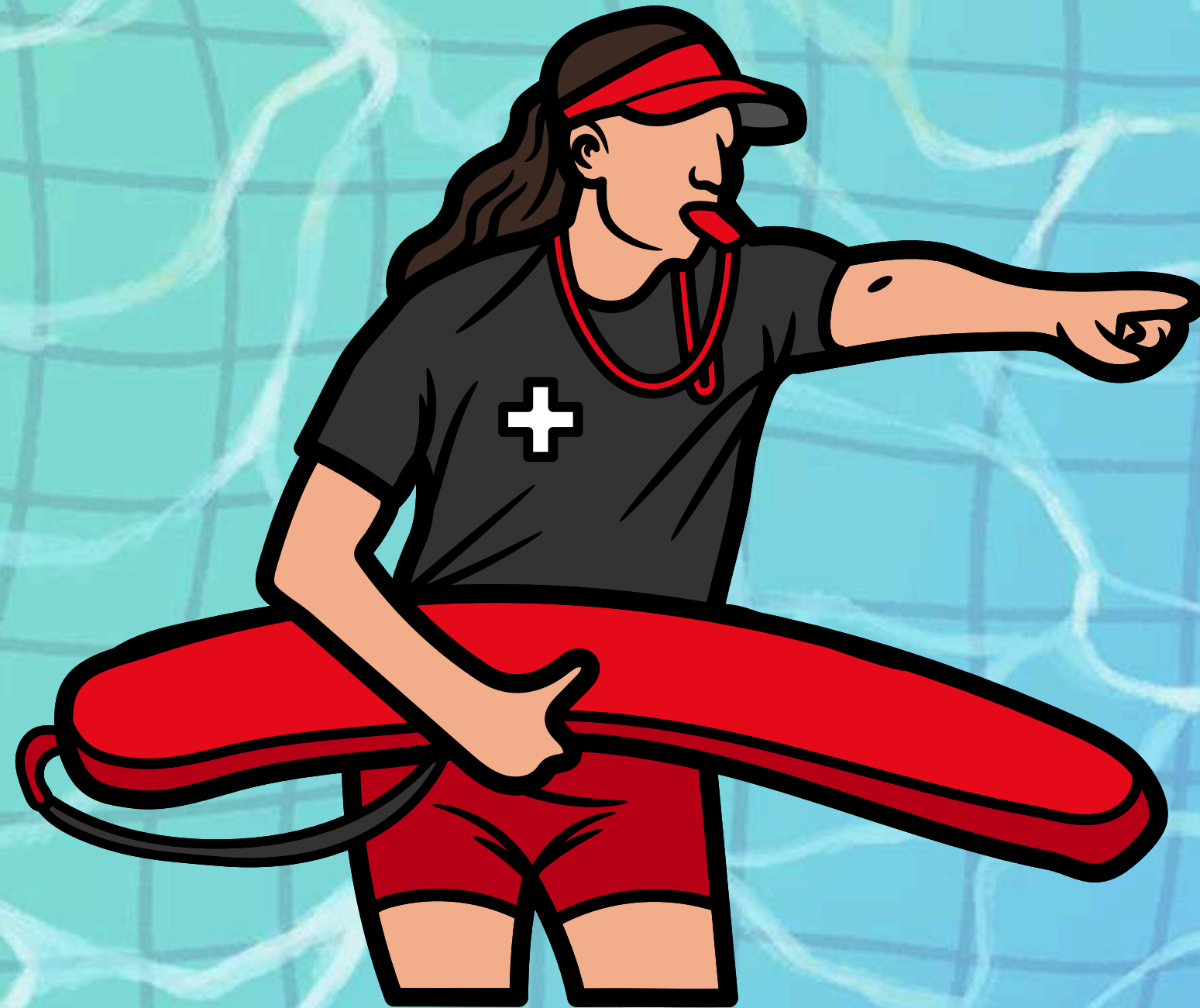
**If I push or splash my friends, they won't want to play
