In December, I can visit Santa! He will be at a mall or store. This is what Santa looks like.

for my turn.**



While waiting in line, it's important not to touch other people or things (like ropes and poles) around me.



When it's my turn to see Santa, I can stand next to him or sit on his knee. I can also hug him or give him a high five if I want! If I'm nervous, my family can come with me.



When it's my turn to see Santa, he will ask me questions. He will ask, "What's your name?" and "What do you want for Christmas?"



I can tell Santa what I want for Christmas by saying “I would like_____.” I can tell him I would like a book, a toy, or a game.



When I am getting my picture taken with Santa, I will try to look at the camera and smile. The person taking the photo might be a photographer or someone from my family.



After my picture has been taken, I can say goodbye to Santa. I can also say “Thank you!” or “Merry Christmas!” to Santa.
