

How to Use

- These cards are to help your child learn what to do in several situations they may encounter at home. You can print them out or review them on a tablet - whatever works best for your child!
- Read the question out loud and pause to let your child answer. Offer input after they are done answering when applicable. For example, if you ask, "What would you do if you were late to class one morning?" And your child answers, "I don't know." You might say, "You can tell the teacher, 'I'm sorry I was late.'"
